

Preaching the Gospel Today – 1 Corinthians 15:1-5

1. Somethings are more important than others.

Verse 3, as of 1st Importance is the Gospel.

The moment you take away the Gospel it seeks to be Christianity.

Chapters 1 to 14 is all important

But Chapter 15 is of 1st Importance = The Gospel

Therefore, the most important thing the preacher does is to preach the Gospel.

For the Gospel is the most Important.

2. Why the Gospel and only the Gospel is of 1st Importance.

Verses 1 & 2 for it's by which you are saved, nothing else can save you, God is angry with all sin.

Also, it is of 1st importance because only by the GOSPEL ALONE do you know that you're a true Christian.

So, you will preach the Gospel using your (time) talents and money in the Gospel cause.

3. What then is the Gospel? Verse 3

The Gospel content it is a definable message, it to be spread by Words with meaning in sentences, therefore, speak clearly.

Its mostly spread by men who preach it, but also by men, women and children who gossip the Gospel by words.

Verses 3 to 5 Is the content of the Gospel.

First, of all the message is about the person Christ which is a title = Messiah.

Poring of oil on the head of Prophets, Priest & Kings when anointed.

Christ the last Prophet who reveals God perfectly. So, he that have seen me has seen the Father.

The Priests prayed for the people and offering up sacrifices to make others acceptable to God. All points to the perfect priest, who is himself the sacrifice, taking away are sins and prays for us His people.

The Kings ruled and make wishes but none where perfectly right or just or fair nor where they all powerful. ONLY CHRIST JESUS is the perfect King who rules His people.

Jesus is the perfect Prophet, Priest and King.

It is not a Christian service unless Christ is in the centre of it.

That Christ died (the History),
For our sins (the reason)

John 3;16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth on Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.

Christ died for are sins according to the scripture.
Isaiah 53;1-12. He was wounded for our transgression.....so, that by His strips we are healed.He bore the sins of all.

And that He was buried (historic fact) and that He rose again on the third day John 20 and He was seen, According to the scriptures.

Question : Do you believe it, and if you do you will never keep your distance from Jesus Christ. But love Him and follow Him, and never want to displease Him.
